Roles and Responsibilities

- Provide mapping services to various business units utilizing supporting GIS data and/or software applications.
- Generate data from multiple sources in order to develop or maintain the following, but not limited to: standard and ad hoc map

production, maintenance of GIS data, one-call reporting, tax rendering, operations permit filing, and DOT and state regulatory reporting.

- Provide information and assistance to external contacts, including engineering, survey companies and one-call vendors.
- Work with user group and business operations, such as business development, field operations, customer service, customer development, engineering and integrity management with support from the Information Technology department.
- Maintain work processes and system capabilities related to GIS applications.

- Assist or provide GIS training and technical support to field analysts and other GIS users.

Requirements

- Associate's or bachelor's degree or certification in Geographic Information Systems (GIS) or related discipline with a projected graduation date prior to June 2012.
- Working knowledge in reading, interpreting and/or preparing written information, including but not limited to right-of-way information, maps, blueprints and legal descriptions.
- Knowledge of applicable GIS-related software.
- Ability to acquire working knowledge in comprehending, reading and following regulatory requirements for the pipeline industry, including company standards and procedures.
- Knowledge and/or training related to: coordinating systems and map projections; developing and formatting standard databases; integrating GPS and analyzing data; source, acquisition, projection or re-projection, accuracy, quality and storage of aerial photography.
