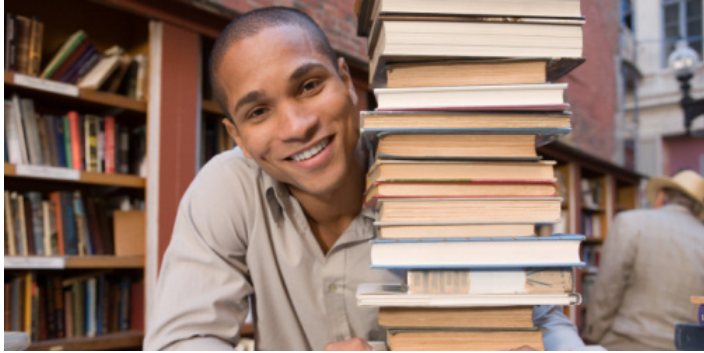

Recruitment process.

ONEOK begins recruiting students in the fall for entry-level positions. Direct-hire opportunities are also available for full-time employment*.

What to expect.

Our orientation program provides the guidance and information you'll need to begin your career at ONEOK. Rotations through ONEOK business segments include experiences that range from office presentations and project assignments to field and plant operations visits, meter reading and fire school. Field visits could include trips to Amarillo, Texas, to see a natural gas pipeline repair or construction project, to Maysville, Oklahoma, to tour a natural gas processing plant, to Medford, Oklahoma, to tour a natural gas liquids fractionation facility, or to Austin, Texas, Oklahoma City or Overland Park, Kansas, to learn about the natural gas distribution business. Groups may also visit the state capitol to learn first-hand about regulatory and government affairs at ONEOK.

Management and peer-mentoring activities provide insight into the company's organizational structure and culture, career development and personal growth opportunities.

The 2012 program is based in Tulsa, but participants will spend approximately five to seven weeks in other areas of the company. Upon completion of the program, you'll be placed into a job assignment based on the company's needs. Your interests and where your talents will make the biggest impact in the organization are taken into consideration. Some members of the orientation class may be aware of their first regular assignment, while others will be advised at the end of the program.
